All plants listed (with the exception of broccoli, cabbage, and cauliflower) are seedlings grown in 4" pots, and are priced at \$2.50/pot. Broccoli, cabbage, and cauliflower are grown in packs of 4, and are priced at \$2.50 per 4-pack.

Onions and beets are grown 4 in a pot. These can be transplanted as they are, to be garden grown in clusters of four.

Potatoes are certified seed potatoes and are priced at \$2.50 per pound.
